EFTA - TURKEY FREE-TRADE AGREEMENT

Communication from Iceland on behalf of the EFTA countries and Turkey

The following communication, dated 5 March 1992, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Iceland on behalf of the EFTA countries and Turkey.

I have the honour to refer to Iceland's statement at the meeting of the Council of Representatives on 18 February 1992 regarding the Free-Trade Agreement between the EFTA countries and Turkey.¹

On behalf of the Governments of the EFTA States (Austria, Finland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Sweden and Switzerland) on the one hand, and of Turkey on the other, and with reference to Article XXIV:7(a) of the General Agreement, I enclose the text of the Agreement between the EFTA States and Turkey with the Annexes and Lists which form an integral part thereof. In addition, the bilateral arrangements between each EFTA State and Turkey, providing for measures² to facilitate trade in agricultural products, are being submitted.
